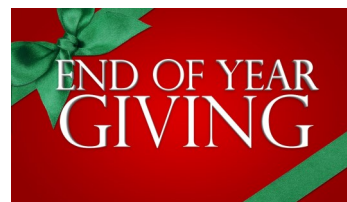

### Thoughts for Today's Readings

**To the Point:** On the third Sunday of Advent, John the Baptist always makes clear that he is not the main character. He is a gifted preacher, gathering a following and compelling many to turn their hearts to God. His work overlaps with what Jesus will do, yet he knows his job is to prepare and foreshadow. Encounter with Christ is still coming, and that is what all his preaching points to. As liturgical ministers in the church, we too are meant to prepare and foreshadow and get out of the way to let the Holy Spirit work. Ministerial work is a sacred partnership with God, but all of it—all our proclaiming and preaching, our work of hospitality, our distribution of Communion, our musical labor—is meant to facilitate and point to encounter with Christ.

**To Experience:** The busyness of the contemporary world is the cause of much anxiety, and these readings invite us to remember that much of what keeps us busy and worried is not of ultimate importance. The second reading, especially, reminds us that Jesus promises peace; his coming will involve letting go but also being restored to ourselves in a holistic and life-giving way. The "chaff" Jesus will burn away includes many of the distractions that occupy our attention, so we should take care not to wrap up our identities in them.

1. The first and second readings both tell us to rejoice, but life does not always lend itself to rejoicing. How do you find the joy God promises in the midst of life's darker seasons?
2. Rest in the last lines of the first reading: know that God rejoices over you and sings joyfully because of you. Is it hard for you to accept such love? What would help you trust in God's delight in you?

### Advent Week Three

The third candle represents Joy. As we continue to approach Christmas Day, our joy grows more and more. It takes us back to the joyful anticipation of the shepherds who journeyed to see Jesus in Bethlehem, even before the wise men.

On this third Sunday of Advent, we light the third candle and rejoice like the shepherds.



### Advent: A Season of Hope, Preparation, and Joy

Dear Friends,

We begin our third week in the season of Advent. This Sunday is known as Gaudete Sunday, we light the Shepherd's candle, a pink candle on our Advent wreath, symbolizing joy. It's a joyful reminder that the coming of Christ is near, and we are called to prepare our hearts with gratitude and rejoicing.

So, why do we call this the Shepherd's candle? The Shepherds in the Christmas event were ordinary people, yet they were the first to hear the angel's message: "Do not be afraid; I bring you good news of great joy for all the people." Despite their humble status, they became witnesses to God's glory, showing that God's joy is for everyone -no matter how simple or lowly.

In the Gospel for this week, John the Baptist calls for a life of repentance demonstrated through acts of justice and generosity. He urges the crowd to share with those in need, to avoid greed, and to act with integrity in their work. John's fiery preaching reminds us that repentance isn't just about feeling sorry for our sins but about a complete transformation of heart and action. He points to Jesus, the one mightier than he, who will baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire. This challenges us to prepare for Christ by living lives of compassion, fairness, and spiritual renewal.

As we reflect on this theme, let us ask ourselves: How can we, like the shepherds, share the joy of Christ with others? Can we offer encouragement to a struggling neighbor, share the Good News with someone searching for meaning, or simply bring a smile to a weary face?

This Advent, as the pink candle brightens our wreath, let it also brighten our hearts. Let us rejoice in the Lord's closeness and spread that joy to those around us. True joy is not just felt but shared, drawing others into the light and love of Christ.

May the Shepherd's candle inspire us to carry joy into our homes, our community, and the world.
