Thoughts for Today's Readings

To the Point: Jesus reveals something of the trinitarian mystery in this gospel. The Father has all and shares it with the Son; the Son in turn shares it with us

and leaves us with the Spirit as teacher and guide. The three are unified in nature and purpose, working in a unity that transcends their division while still leaving it intact. This mystery is one that we do not fully comprehend in this life, so it is okay if Jesus' words seem cryptic. The mystery, though, is not meant to shut us out. It is, rather, an invitation to enter into a lifetime journey of love with this God who is love.

To Experience: Scripture often uses human relationships as images of God. The Trinity has a Father and a Son, and they are in relationship, which tells us something about God's nature. The mystery of the Trinity tells us that God is love, which means that all our loving relationships are a place where we encounter God and learn something about who God is. This is true of all kinds of relationships—between parents and children, between spouses, between siblings, between friends.

- How do you experience the Spirit's guidance? How does the Spirit speak into your life?
- Today's first reading from Proverbs claims that the Wisdom of God (often identified by the Christian tradition of Jesus) is *play-ful*. How does this image fit with your working image of God? What might it add to your understanding of Jesus?
- 3. The Trinity's love pours out as a life-giving creativity. What are some wonders of the natural world that draw your attention to God?

"God in Relationship, God in Love"

Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity, a central mystery of our Faith. The readings draw us into the profound beauty of a God who is not distant or abstract, but a communion of love—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

In the first reading, we hear the poetic voice of Wisdom, present with God from the beginning. This "Wisdom" has often been seen by the Church as a foreshadowing of Christ—co-creating with the Father, delighting in humanity. It reminds us that relationship and joy are part of the very nature of God.

St. Paul, in the second reading, speaks of how our justification through Christ brings peace with God, and through the Holy Spirit, God's love is poured into our hearts. Here, the Trinity is not just a theological truth, but a lived reality: we are drawn into the life of the Triune God through grace.


In the Gospel of John, Jesus promises that the Spirit of truth will guide the disciples into all truth, revealing what belongs to the Father and the Son. This dynamic movement—Father to Son to Spirit—is not only about Revelation, but about sharing divine life with us.


The Trinity is not a puzzle to be solved but a mystery to be entered. As human beings made in God's image, we are called to reflect this divine relationship in our own lives—through love, unity, and self-aiving.

Let today be a reminder that we belong to a God who is not solitary but eternally relational. May we live as a people drawn into the heart of this divine love—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

In Praise of the Trinity

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

This short prayer of praise known as the Glory Be comes at the end of each decade of the rosary, but it is not simply a closing prayer. Rather it is meant to express the peak of our contemplation. Praise of the Holy Trinity is the Christian response to the events of salvation that God has accomplished in his Son.

We praise God for his becoming man and dwelling among us; for his death, which conquered sin; for his resurrection, which gives us new life; for his ascension to the right hand of the Father; and for sending the Holy Spirit to us at Pentecost (CCC, 2641).
