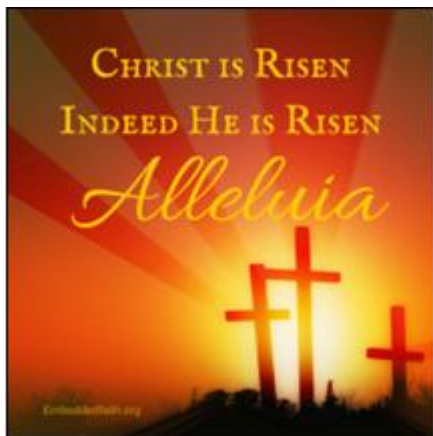
Rice Bowls will be Collected beginning next weekend. Look for a collection 'box' at the back of church. Thank you.

Thoughts for Today's Readings



To the Point: Each of us is commissioned to share the gospel of Jesus, both in word and action. This call begins with the experience of

Mary Magdalene at the tomb of Easter morning and is exemplified by Peter's proclamation in the first reading from Acts. Sharing the Scriptures at Mass is one way of doing this, of course, but the whole of our lives should also be touched by Easter joy. Paul conveys this in today's epistle reading – in the resurrection of Christ, each of us is offered the grace to welcome the kingdom of God into our families, communities, and relationships.

1. In the gospel reading, Mary Magdalene is initially unable to believe that Jesus has risen, instead thinking that his body must have been carried away. What prevents you from seeing God's action in your life?
2. In the first reading from Acts, Peter shares the story of Jesus with Cornelius, a Roman centurion sent to him by an angel. How are you called to witness to the resurrection in this Easter season?

A Love That Cannot Sleep

Mary Magdalene couldn't wait for the sun to rise. While it was still dark, her devotion drove her to the tomb. She didn't stay home to mourn in peace; her heart was restless because her Lord was gone. This is the mark of true love: it doesn't wait for convenience or daylight. It seeks Jesus even in the darkest hours.

The Race of Devotion

When Mary came back to Jerusalem and shared the news with Simon Peter and John, they didn't just walk—they ran. John, fueled by his deep bond with Jesus, outran Peter to the tomb. Their sprint shows us that when Jesus is your greatest treasure, you move with urgency. You don't hesitate when there is a chance to be near Him.

The First to Believe

John was the first to see the empty linens and believe in the Resurrection. Before a single word was spoken by the risen Christ, John's heart recognized the truth. Their love wasn't just a feeling; it was the lens through which they saw a miracle.

Our Call Today

Does our love for Jesus wake us up? Does it make us run? Let's move with the same urgency as Mary, Peter, and John, seeking the Living God with everything we have throughout our lives.

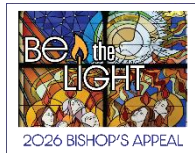

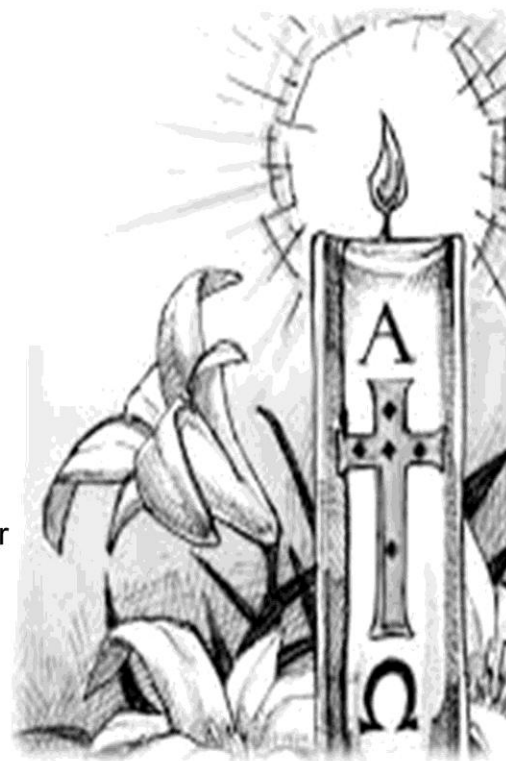
